

01Well Planning & Engineering

With in-house expertise in well planning and engineering, Lucas provides a comprehensive suite of services to optimise the entire lifecycle of your project. From initial design and feasibility studies to detailed engineering and operational support, our team ensures every well is planned for maximum efficiency, safety, and performance.



02Exploration Drilling

Our professional drilling crews coupled with our modern well-maintained and multi-purpose rigs are able to undertake a wide range of exploration drilling activities Including down hole hammer, diamond core, conventional core and rotary mud drilling.



03Directional Drilling

Lucas undertakes more than 120,000 metres of directional drilling annually, delivering safe, efficient, and innovative solutions such as surface to inseam wells and HDD for mine degasification and dewatering. We support our clients with our multi-purpose directional drilling fleet and in-house team of engineers and steerers.



Provides advanced directional drilling capabilities including geosteering, ranging, and well intersection expertise in varying ground conditions. Using BMR, MWD, and LWD tools, we ensure precise wellbore placement, maximise zone residency, and avoid hazards.



05GOAF Drainage & Service Wells

Lucas provides leading capability in drilling GOAF wells and service bores for mine ventilation, gas drainage, and production applications. We specialise in vertical and angled well designs, with the capacity to drill and case wells up to 36" (914mm) diameter, ensuring robust infrastructure for long-term performance.



06 Well Servicing

Lucas performs well installations, well commissioning and maintenance as well as the installation of surface infrastructure, monitoring systems, gas gathering lines and flares.



Case Study

Project: Open Cut Depressurisation Project



Initial Problem

- The mine required access to a target seam via a new box cut, targeting unmined coal.
- Piezometer data showed hydrostatic pressure (~2300 kPa) and gas content up to 12 m³/t (methane) at shallow depths.
- High pressure and gas content created safety risks, potentially creating an unsafe explosive loading and mining environment.

Project Objectives

- 01 Depressurise the seam for safe, continuous mining.
- 02 Use innovative Surface to In Seam (SIS) bilateral gas drainage wells.
- Maintain safety and minimise delays; explore gas utilisation and NGERs benefits.

Technical Approach and

Key Learnings

- SIS well design and underbalanced drilling enabled safe completion of the laterals.
- A robust risk assessment process and real-time rig monitoring provide excellent guidance for decision making.
- Lucas Drilling's integrated project delivery and collaboration with the client, client consultant and site teams ensured success.
- Frequent budget review and cost tracking ensured the project budget was not exceeded
- Adaptability and resilience overcame geological and operational challenges.

Well Infrastructure


